## General Rules & Information

- Competitors, please be aware that, at your discretion, you must be covered by your own Personal Accident Insurance for this Event.
- The organising committee and the Hunt do not accept liability for any accident, damage or injury to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.
- Age of Rider for entry taken as at date of event.
- All ponies/horses must be four years & over.
- Regulation hats with PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) and VG01.040 2014-12, all with BSI Kitemark or Inspec IC Mark must be worn at all times when mounted. Body protectors to comply with EN13158 and a recognised BETA level 2 or 3 and medical armbands must also be worn.
- Plaques will be awarded to the winner of each age group in the Cross Country Classes. Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> place in all classes.
- Please note: once the competition has started, some areas of the course may be roped off.
- Any competitor reporting late risks elimination.
- Competitors to go in numerical order round the Cross Country. **This is not a Pick- a- Fence**. Riders to jump a set course - there will be penalties for jumping a lower fence, but no bonus marks for jumping a higher fence - no deviation at all from course in timed section. Anyone worried about height may go HC but remain in age group.
- A veterinary surgeon will be on call but all expenses incurred are the responsibility of the competitor.
- **NO DOGS ALLOWED ON THE COURSE AT ANY TIME, IN THE AREA OF THE COMPETITIONS OR IN THE CAR PARK**. We are sorry to be strict about this, but it is a condition upon which we are allowed to be here at all.
- Any objections must be made to the secretary accompanied by a deposit of £10 within 15 minutes of the scores being displayed.
- No refunds after the closing date.
- In the event of cancellation £5 per horse will be retained to cover costs. Refunds will be sent on receipt of a SAE.
- The course may be walked after 2pm on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> April. Times will be listed on the secretary's caravan and posted on the Hunt website at [www.cvnvh.org.uk](http://www.cvnvh.org.uk).
